## Kim Illingworth



**October 12, 1960 - February 11, 2006**

The Regina Mens Broomball League is mourning the loss of one of its long standing members. Kim Illingworth passed away on Saturday Feb. 11<sup>th</sup>/2006 after a brave battle with cancer. He was 45 years of age. Kim started playing Broomball in 1979 with the Regina Bullets where he captained the team to many successful seasons. He then became a member of the Regina Senators in 1987 where he played until 2004 when his illness was diagnosed. Kim was a highly skilled and very competitive player who was well known and respected around the league as well as around the province. With the Senators, Kim won numerous individual awards as the leagues top defenseman and his dominant playing style also lead the team to many league and city championships as well as a number of provincial championships. His skills also earned him an invitation to attend the 2000 Senior Nationals in Halifax with the Silver Screen Bruins. His highly competitive demeanor on the ice seemed a sharp contrast to his fun loving nature off ice and he will truly be missed by teammates and opponents alike. The Regina Mens Broomball League Non Contact division recently announced it was renaming the top defenseman award in Kim's honour.

## Masters Age

There has been some confusion regarding the age for this years Masters Championships. A motion was submitted in April 2005 to change the age of the Masters category from 40 back to 35 years of age for the Mens division. This motion was brought forward to the AGM in May 2005 in Saskatoon and this motion was carried.

The age for this year's Masters tournament in Odessa (March 25<sup>th</sup>) will be 35 as of the date of the tournament for the Mens division and 30 years of age as of the date of the tournament for the ladies division.
