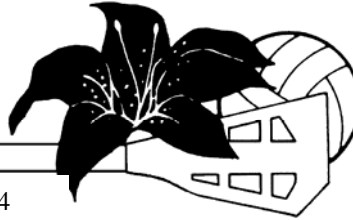

CRITERIA

1. HALL OF FAME AWARD

The Saskatchewan Broomball Association has, in its past, a number of people whose devotion and or accomplishments in the sport of broomball has been seen as outstanding.

- The nominee must have served sport for a period of years, not necessarily consecutive.
- The nominee must have had a career which combines, wholly or in part, the bringing of credit to broomball in such a way as to make their contribution to broomball of an outstanding nature.
- The nominee must be retired from the sport of broomball for at least two full years.

2. SERVICE AWARD

The Saskatchewan Broomball Association has in its membership a few choice people that have chosen to spend much of their personal time devoted to broomball. These people have chosen to develop, and encourage growth within our sport through their non-playing involvement. This award will honour these people in order to, not only validate, but reward their efforts for all our benefit.

- The nominee must have served sport for a period of years, not necessarily consecutive.
- The nominee must have had a career which combines, wholly or in part, the bringing of credit to broomball in such a way as to make their contribution to broomball of an outstanding nature.

- Athletes must be in good standing.

REQUIRED DETAILS

In order to properly complete this application the following types of information are required. Please provide details suitable to the award being sought.

- Individuals/team Broomball accomplishments and contributions;
 - win/loss record, medals or placing in league, tournaments, major championships, all star awards, position played, executive or other volunteer contributions, years served, years playing, years coaching, etc.
 - in the previous year
 - in prior yearsPlease be as complete as possible.
- Personal information - age, years in Broomball, other interests and accomplishments, place of employment, family background (married, children, etc.), humorous stories, etc. Provide items of note that will assist the committee in the presentation of the award should the applicant be successful.
- Why should this individual/team be awarded the award? Provide your thoughts on the unique contribution made by this individual/team.
- Contact information: Names (and detailed contact information) of individuals who may be able to provide additional details to accompany this application (E.g. Names of assistant coaches, league executive members, spouse, teammates, etc.)
