## **Senior Category Meeting**

The Senior Category Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at 6:00pm. This year the meeting will be held via videoconferencing from Regina and Saskatoon. Northern teams are asked to attend in Saskatoon at 510 Cynthia St (Sask Lotteries office) and the South teams are asked to attend in Regina at 1870 Lorne St (Sask Sport office).

Please be reminded that all teams planning on attending the Senior Provincial Championships in Regina this season must have a team rep in attendance at this meeting.

This is the most important meeting of the year for the Senior Category as this is where the 'A' and 'B' splits are decided. Contact your Senior Category Chairperson if you would like more details about this meeting.

### **Membership Assistance Program**

The MAP Grant Program is available to the members of the SBA again this season. Approximately \$13,500 will be distributed to SBA members who have undertaken projects that encourage membership growth. Members are encouraged to contact their category chairpersons for more information.

#### MAP Application Procedure:

- 1. Fill out the MAP spending plan form with your signature and date (forms available from the SBA office or on the SBA Website).
- 2. Submit your completed application form to the SBA office by January 17<sup>th</sup>. The approval meeting will be held shortly after the deadline.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of their grant status. All successful applicants will receive their follow up package to be completed and sent back to the SBA office by April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 4. Final decision on the amount of each grant and the issue of cheques will be made in May.
- 5. A percentage (determined by the MAP committee) of the total amount may be paid prior to May 1<sup>st</sup> for completed projects.

## Saskatoon Sports Hall of Fame Inductee – Terry Forbes

Terry Forbes was inducted into the Saskatoon Sports Hall of Fame and Museum on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010.



Terry Forbes has played or lent organizational skills to bowling, fastball, baseball and soccer, but his most outstanding leadership skills were in building a provincial and national image for Broomball.

In Broomball, he was a member of the board which established the Saskatchewan Broomball Association in 1976 and the Canadian Broomball Federation in 1977. He has been president of the Saskatoon Broomball League and long time committee member of the Saskatoon Gold Broom Tournament – the longest running tournament in Canada in its 41<sup>st</sup> year.

He has been president, tournament chair and workshop instructor with the SBA. Terry has been a director and secretary of the CBF as well.

In 1994, he formed a Team Canada entry to travel to Japan's national championship and the Canadians went undefeated. He was honoured with the Sask Sport Volunteer Recognition award in 1992, and induction into the Canadian Broomball Federation Hall of Fame in 2004.

## Yorkton Sports Hall of Fame Inductee – Rod Merritt

Rod Merritt was inducted into the Yorkton Sports Hall of Fame and Museum on May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.



Rod Merritt's stint with the sport of broomball began around 1958, not far from Yorkton. About 6 years later, he moved to Thompson, MB and continued his playing days. Shortly after, from 1970 - 1972 he played in Saskatoon before moving on to play with some of the top teams in the Edmonton area.

His tremendous insight and understanding of the game earned him an elected position as the first President of the Alberta Broomball Association in 1976. He held a position as Director for various years in the 70's. He played in the Western Canadian Championships from 1968 - 1975, and was a Director and Tournament Chair for these Championships for 5 years.

The list of Rod's accomplishments are countless. He held various Executive positions from 1980 – 1995. Rod holds Provincial Championships In Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta. Led by Merritt in 2005, Yorkton hosted the Mens and Ladies "A" and "B" Provincial Championships; it earned TV coverage and was ranked the top Broomball event ever held in the city of Yorkton. In honor of Rod's loyalty and dedication to the sport of broomball, last spring the SBA awarded him the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Leadership Award.

Rod was involved in many other sports, however, despite his versatility, when it comes to the Sport of Broomball, without a doubt, as a player, and coach, to running clinics; as a Director and an organizer; his longevity is second to none, spanning more than 40 years.
