## **Senior Category Meeting**

The Senior Category Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at 10:30am. This year the meeting will be held via videoconferencing from Regina and Saskatoon. Northern teams are asked to attend in Saskatoon at 510 Cynthia St (Sask Lotteries office) and the South teams are asked to attend in Regina at 2205 Victoria Ave (Admin Centre).

Please be reminded that all teams planning on attending the Senior Provincial Championships in Prince Albert this season must have a team rep in attendance at this meeting.

This is the most important meeting of the year for the Senior Category. Contact your Senior Category Chairperson if you would like more details about this meeting.

### **Membership Assistance Program**

The MAP Grant Program is available to the members of the SBA again this season. Approximately \$20,900 will be distributed to SBA members who have undertaken projects that encourage membership growth. Members are encouraged to contact their category chairpersons for more information.

#### MAP Application Procedure:

- 1. Fill out the MAP spending plan form with your signature and date (forms available from the SBA office or on the SBA Website).
- 2. Submit your completed application form to the SBA office by January 15<sup>th</sup>. The approval meeting will be held shortly after the deadline.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of their grant status. All successful applicants will receive their follow up package to be completed and sent back to the SBA office by April 15<sup>th</sup>.
- 4. Final decision on the amount of each grant and the issue of cheques will be made in May.
- 5. A percentage (determined by the MAP committee) of the total amount may be paid prior to May 1<sup>st</sup> for completed projects.





## **Registration Deadlines**

A reminder to all teams and coaches that the deadline for Registration Fees and Provincial Rosters is as follows for each category:

<u>Senior</u> – Preliminary rosters and registration fees are due at the January meeting (January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014). Deadline for additions to the preliminary roster is February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

**Non Contact** – Registration fees and final rosters are due February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

<u>Minor</u> – Registration fees and final rosters are due February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015.

<u>Mixed</u> – Registration fees and final rosters are due February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2015.
