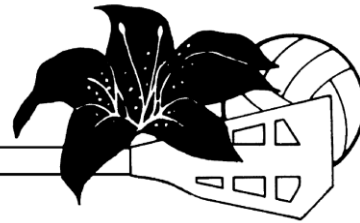

BROOMBALL TO COMPETE (BTC) COACHING CLINIC – September/October Fall 2020

The Saskatchewan Broomball Association and Broomball Canada are looking to host a Broomball to Compete Coaching Clinic in the fall of 2020. This will hopefully be a virtual option this fall, just waiting on direction from the CBF.

The Broomball to Compete Clinic (BTC) is replacing both the old Level 1 and the Level 2 coaching programs. Training in the BTC context will consist of a 15 hour workshop and modules that cover topics such as Skills Foundation, Planning, Skills Analysis, and Teaching and Supporting the Athlete. The coach will also be required to complete a 3.5 hour Making Ethical Decisions workshop in order to become BTC Trained.

For a coach to become BTC Certified, the coach will be required to build a portfolio that includes 3 lesson plans, an emergency action plan, a skills analysis assignment, and a completed self-assessment and peer assessment. They will also need to be observed coaching in a practice setting in person or by submitting a video to a qualified evaluator (SK has 2 certified Evaluators). The final step will be to complete an online evaluation of the Making Ethical Decisions module.

Certification will be for a five year period after registration as “Certified”. Certification will be maintained provided the coach has been active for two years of the five year period and has obtained three professional development credits during the certification period.

The SBA has minimum requirements for its coaches that intend on coaching at the Minor and Senior Levels. These minimum requirements are Fully Certified Level 1 (from the old coaching system) or BTC Certified (new coaching system). As of 2013 Broomball Canada will require coaches at the Nationals to be BTC Certified. Plus we expect down the road all coaches will be required to have their BTC to coach at any Saskatchewan Provincials.

We are very fortunate that Broomball Canada has chosen to host another BTC course in Saskatchewan and we encourage all interested coaches to attend this clinic. The cost to register for the BTC course is \$300.00 payable to the SBA. There also is a Making Ethical Decisions course you’ll need to complete and that’s an online course (paid online) and it’s \$85. A portion of these fees may be recovered through your team MAP Grant eligibility. Please refer to the MAP Grant guidelines for your category for details on this eligibility.



BROOMBALL TO COMPETE (BTC) EVALUATIONS

The CBF have announced that all coaches who are coaching at Senior or Juvenile Nationals effective 2017 will need to be fully Certified BTC coaches, which means they will need to complete their Evaluations in order to be on the bench at Nationals. Any coaches in the Mixed/Co-Ed Category have until 2018 to be fully Certified BTC.

Any of the coaches in Saskatchewan who took the BTC course in Regina in 2012 MUST get their Evaluation done this year or their BTC training will lapse (as it's the 5 year deadline) and they will have to retake the BTC training over again. Anyone who has taken it in 2013 or 2014, the SBA advises you start making a plan to have your evaluations done as well so you don't fall into this tight of a deadline.

If there are multiple coaches in one area who need evaluations, please coordinate this with those coaches, as the CBF will not send out an evaluator for 1 coach, it must be cost effective to do this. Please get in touch with the CBF regarding your Evaluation and then they will get in touch with an Evaluator for you to complete this process. You'll be asked to complete your portfolio (which was part of your training packages) and send that into the CBF as well. If you have questions about this you can call Stacey at the SBA office, just remember though it's not managed through the SB

Earning PD Points to Ensure you keep your BTC Status (This is your responsibility as a coach)

Once you are Broomball to Compete Certified you have five years to complete 20 PD points.

Here is how you go about doing this. From Coaching Associations of Canada (CAC www.coach.ca), Go into the Locker, sign-in using your NCCP# or Email plus your password. If you have forgotten your password, you can contact the Coaching Coordinator by Email (cmorneau@videotron.ca) or phone CAC 1-613-235-5000 to reset it.

Go to the Certification Section. It is on this page that you will find the date of your certification and when the certification will expire. You will also be advised of how many PD points you have, if any.

The easiest way to get some points is to go to Self-Report on the left-hand side of the Certification page. Press on the whistle, you will see record active status. Start with the year you were certified and then add a year or years. i.e. 2013, 2014, 2015 etc. You can add you can add up to five years. That is one point per year.

On the other side of the same page you will see Record Professional Development. Press on the word type and you will notice some choices. You will get one point for each choice up to 3 points per five years.

Now go back to the Certification Page and press eLearning. These choices should appear on the left-hand side and are under Multi Sport.

- Coaching Athletes with a Disability
- Making Headway in Sport (Dealing with Concussions)
- Coach Initiation in Sport

These courses are usually worth 5 points each.

There are also 2 other courses that may interest you: Leading Drug Free Sport Online Evaluation or Managing Conflict Online Evaluation

If you can't find eLearning you can also look under Coach Training. Be a Coach can be found at the top of the Certification Page and by pressing this it will take you to a short session on the Be a Coach – Four Steps to Get Coaching. You can add this to one of your Record Professional Development. The sooner you get to adding PD Points the better.
