1909 - The 100th Anniversary of Broomball

The Saskatchewan Broomball Association is very lucky to have obtained funding to research, write and publish a book on the History of Broomball in Saskatchewan. This project has been underway for a number of years and is currently in the writing phase. The publication of the book is on schedule for early 2010. The book will tell the story of the evolution of the sport from a game played at winter carnivals to the elite sport that has now developed all over the world. Broomball is truly unique, as National & International events continue to be popular, there still is a demand and a lot of fun to be had at the recreational level.

During the research phase of this project, a newspaper article was discovered in the March 6/1909 edition of the Saskatoon Star Phoenix. The article reported a Broomball game played on Mar 5/1909 in Perdue (a small town a few km outside of the city of Saskatoon) between the employees of the Perdue Hotel and the employees of the town office. Prior to this article, the oldest report of a Broomball game was from Massey, Ontario in 1911. The Massey newspaper published a picture displaying a Broomball game being played on a football field covered in snow - the goal posts were visible and being used as goals.

Since the 1909 article was discovered, considerable additional research has been conducted and the 1909 game continues to be the oldest documented report of a game of Broomball.

SBA Centennial Celebrations

The SBA challenged the town of Perdue to a Broomball game on Feb 5th. The game was very recreational in nature and all that participated had a great time. The SBA showed a bit more experience on the ice and managed to win the game 4-0. Thanks to Terry Forbes and the town of Perdue for organizing and making this event an enjoyable one.



2009 Senior Canadian Broomball National Championship

Saskatoon, SK April 1 – 4, 2009

The 2009 Senior Broomball Championship took place in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan from April 1^{st} - 4^{th} . All teams had the option of three hotels: Host Hotel being the Travelodge Hotel, the Hilton Garden Inn, or the Radisson Hotel. All hotels, restaurants, amenities, and banquet were located no further than 17 minutes from the arena and other hotels; even with the banquet being located five minutes out of the city. Transportation options were also given in our information packages a year prior to the event at the AGM with the strong recommendation to book well in advance due to another large event taking place in Saskatoon at the same time. The arena choice was Harold Latrace Arena, located in Saskatoon, with two ice surfaces, large spectator viewing areas, adequate facilities & dressing rooms, and an upstairs lounge.

This year we had 12 men's teams participating: NWT (Yellowknife Ravens), QC (Pogos Rancuniers), Defending Champs (Frost), ON (Ottawa Nationals), SK Host (Odessa Outlaws), SK (Bruno Axemen), AB (Calgary Blazers), MB (Rebels), NB (Les Etoiles), AB2 (Calgary Chiefs), ON2 (Rookies) & SK2 (Regina Sportsman). On the ladies side we had 10 participating teams: NWT (Rebels), QC (Huskies), ON (Vipers), Defending Champs (McMillan Sand & Gravel), SK Host (Odessa Storm), SK (Saskatoon Flyers), AB (Edmonton Wasabi), MB (Hexx), ON2 (OSS) & SK2 (Regina Ice Devils).

Teams & Provincial Associations were contacted via email a week prior to the event and were assigned team picture times along with any significant information or changes that were vital to the Host Committee or the teams regarding the process of the championship, and not to mention how excited we were to have them all arriving. We received the team & Provincials Association contact information from the Canadian Broomball Federation. Event information was available on our website (www.2009broomballnationals.ca) for the past year and updated instantly as changes occurred. One month prior to the championship we had all of our events with place, time & detail to ensure that our visitors had relevant information in a timely manner.

In addition to the honor of hosting this championship in Saskatoon in 2009 we celebrated the 100th Anniversary of Broomball in Saskatchewan. The Saskatchewan Broomball Association and Terry Forbes hosted the CBF Hall of Fame on Monday, March 30th inducting Brian Klenk into the Hall of Fame as well as some others who received separate appreciation awards that have contributed their time and efforts to make Broomball in Saskatchewan what it is today. We are stimulated on the amount of pride & passion that goes into our sport! The evening was noted to be enjoyable & entertaining.

Through our website we posted available times for team practices on Tuesday, March 31st and teams were responsible for contacting the Host Committee via the website with their requested time, pay by cheque and when the money was received via mail, their time was secured. We offered the teams/coaches an option for team registration. They were able to register on Tuesday, March 31st at the Harold Latrace arena during the day or at the Host Hotel, Travelodge Hotel prior to the coaches meeting. Everything ran smoothly and was productive. We requested that teams paid for

their banquet tickets at registration and any other outstanding dues, such as practice payment that was not received in the mail. Following team registration the coaches and officials meeting was held in the Hercules Lancaster room at the Host Hotel, Travelodge Hotel, which also ran typically well.

Wednesday, April 1st was the kick off to our long, awaited event; the Championship begins! The Opening Ceremonies were held at the Harold Latrace Arena at 7:00 o'clock in the evening with all participants, coaches, sponsors, volunteers & spectators seated up in the stands. With the red carpet laid and provincial flags high the overall event was a success. The ceremony started with Carmen Manderschied, Laura Hoffman & Andrea Hoffman singing the Canadian anthem. We had special speakers from the Province of Saskatchewan - MLA Joceline Schriemer, City of Saskatoon - Councilor Maurice Nault, President of the Saskatchewan Broomball Association, Don Gray, President of the Canadian Broomball Federation, Rick Pryzbysz, Host Committee Chairperson, Darla Wyatt, athletes oath read by Ashley Kosowan & Jason Basset and lastly our emcee was bilingual, Mr. Cyril Deault. To wrap up the ceremonies the Bruno High School Cheerleaders entertained the crowd with a fantastic routine! The opening ceremonies were short and sweet and everyone gave great feedback from the night. April 2nd and April 3rd round robin and semi finals continued wrapping up on April 4th with the final games and medal/closing ceremonies.

The banquet was held out at the Manhattan Ballroom on Saturday, April 4th. The Host Committee offered bus services from the Host Hotel, Travelodge Hotel to the Manhattan Ballroom and return. The program included cocktails, introductions, buffet dinner, awards presentation and a dance to follow. The Host Committee hired bartenders and security to ensure safety and accountability throughout the evening. This night, like always, was a ton of fun and a huge success. There are no records of any altercations or damages done.

In summary to the 2009 Broomball Nationals event is was high energy, fast paced, rewarding experience and a big achievement. The volunteer Host Committee put in over two years of planning to see their dedication, commitment, diligence, & patience be captured in a four day event that was hands down, "one of the best nationals I've ever been to!" Anonymous. The strength it takes to commit to what seems like a never ending planning process shows their pride and passion for the sport they love. We did not create an event evaluation to be filled out by participants or spectators but instead monitored the week by noting verbal comments, suggestions, concerns, praises, etc. With very little to report on the negative side of things, we are happy to testify that everything was communicated as positive and appreciative. Saskatoon looks forward to hosting the nationals again in the near future!


